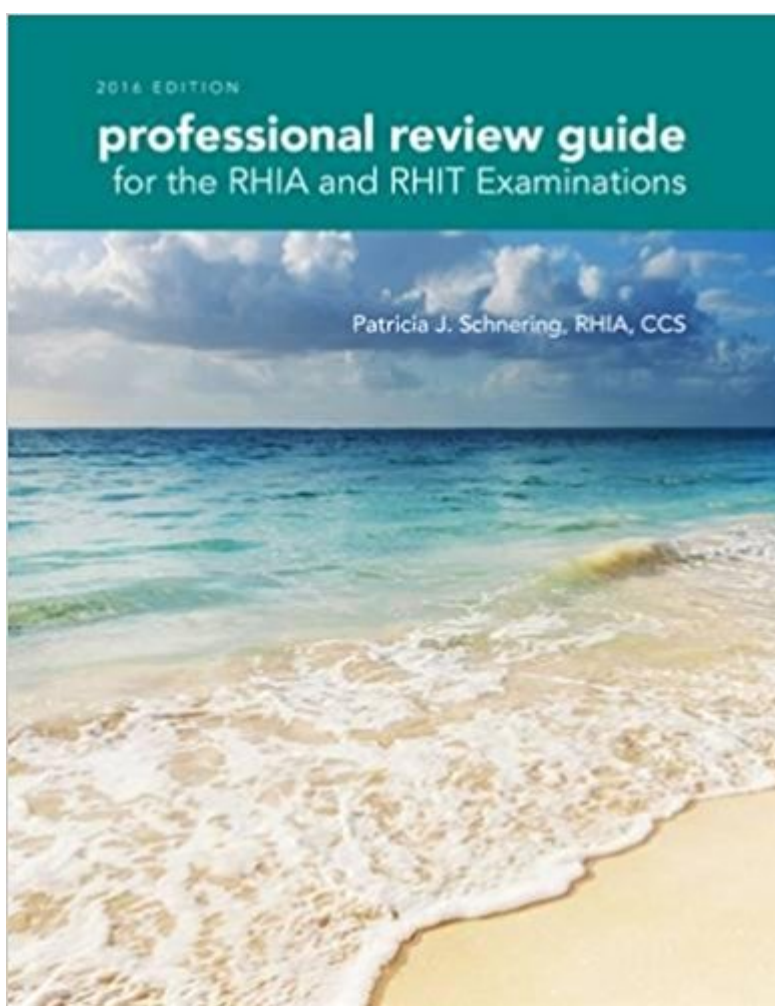

No, I absolutely would not recommend this study guide. It is riddled with errors in the answer keys. These errors could mean the difference between someone passing or failing the RHIA exam. I find it incredibly irresponsible that they exist.

I just took the RHIT exam on Friday for the first time and passed with a 356. I mainly used the 2016 PRG to study from. I did have the 4th version of the AHIMA study guide and found that it was not that helpful when I actually took the test. The PRG covers all the right topics for the exam and formats the questions more a similar manner to the actual test (though neither book is worded exactly like how the test is). I used the online tests and just took them over and over again. I used both the Johns and the Sayles book to look up any answers I got wrong. My exam had hardly any stats questions and the ones that were on there were very simple. Only a handful of coding questions and those weren't that difficult either- take time to study principle dx and sequencing rules. There was quite a few IT questions regarding databases and their content. That was probably my worst section- scored a 74. I wish I had taken more time to study the IT and data management concepts. Several questions regarding qualitative vs quantitative review, not many HR type questions, the National Provider Data Bank came up on at least 3 questions...Some of the questions were poorly worded and were just bad grammar wise so you need to read carefully. I flagged the ones I wasn't sure on and then went back and reviewed those. After I reviewed the flagged questions I reviewed the entire test from start to finish. I still had about an hour and half left on my timer when I submitted. These note cards have the main concepts you should know for the exam and provides excellent explanations. [...]

This book has tons of errors. I have purchased it and started preparing for my RHIT with it, but unfortunately I had to stop, because of so many errors that I have noticed (and what about those that I have not). All of my classmates had the same experience:(Would definitely not recommend it.

Required to purchase this for review sessions in the HIM bachelors program. We review each chapter question by question and my professors have noticed a large amount of errors. Errors in the answer choices and a ton of errors in the answer key. One professor noticed his entire sections (reviews of courses he taught) were incorrect. They are not going to use this book for future reviews for seniors.

There are a lot of errors.

Too many errors to be trusted. Even the references are wrong. Very poor study guide for a test that requires a degree to take.

I used this book in conjunction with the AHIMA RHIT exam prep book. I passed the RHIT exam first attempt.
