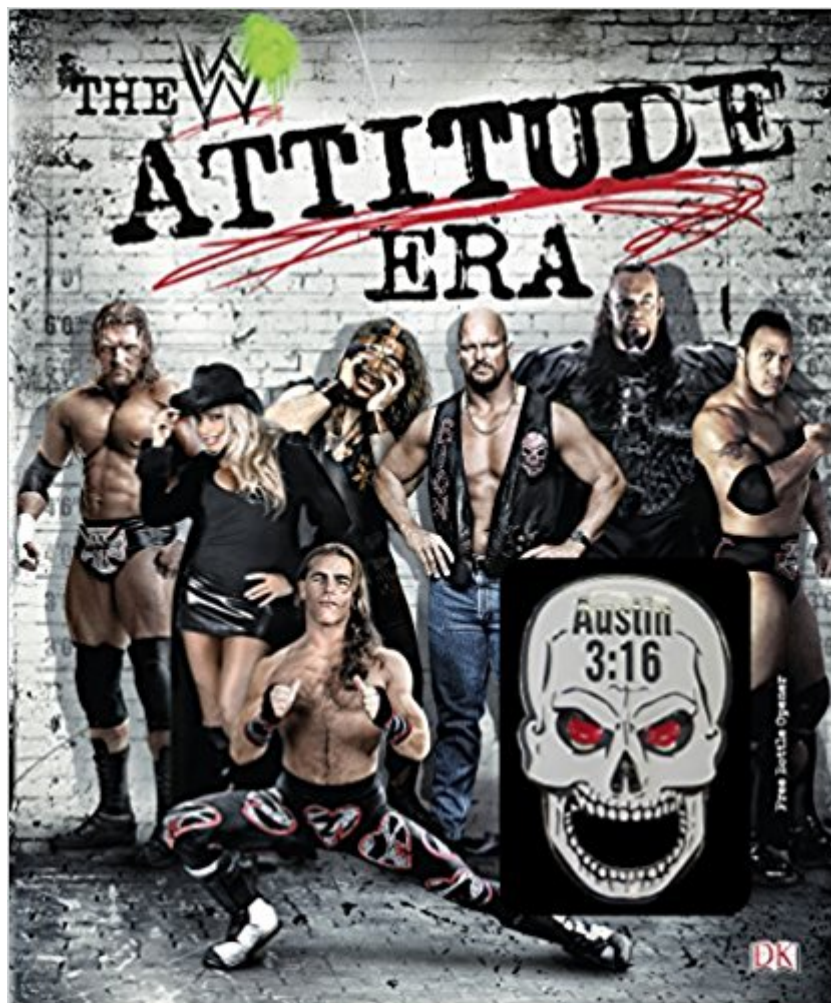

This book goes over the entire Monday Night War and what is now called the Attitude Era in great detail from an outside Kayfabe (In storyline) perspective. With over 200 fully colored and nicely printed pages, this is definitely worth the price of admission.

Great book, definitely deserves the buy if you want to be entertained in a sense. I bought it for an essay I was writing about the Attitude Era, and I expected it to have all the bits and pieces regarding that era; it rather had what superstars thought about the era and the most memorable 'wrestlers' back then. If you're really into that era, I would recommend you check the following: This book, 'WWE 50' book, the Monday Night War series on the WWE Network, and the rise and fall of WCW (also found on the network).
