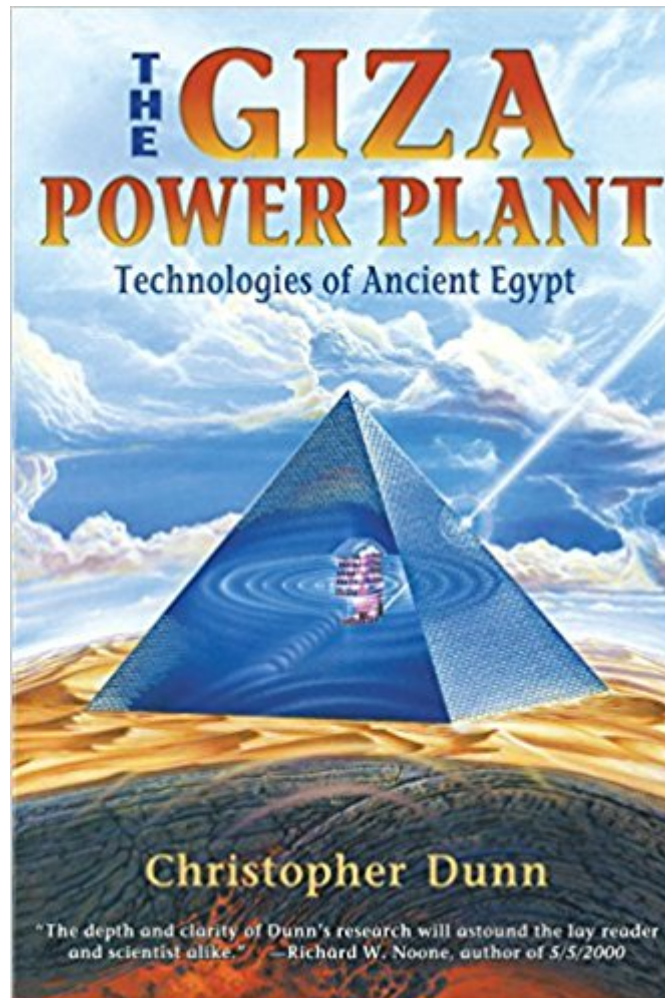

In this case, however, it may be fact. In writing *The Giza Power Plant*, mechanical engineer Christopher Dunn reverse-engineered the Great Pyramid at Giza to discover its use. His startling conclusions blow the heck out of traditional Egyptology's rather silly notions that it was built with copper tools by a society that lacked the wheel. Since I have a bachelor's degree in manufacturing engineering and am now retired, I found Chris Dunn's theory to be particularly interesting. I know from my own shop experience just how difficult it truly is to repeat high tolerance work on even small, as in what you can hold in the palm of your hand, parts much less something the size of the King's Chamber. And since one of my main functions was chief estimator for putting a price to this kind of work, I also have a pretty good handle on how much work like this costs. So, to suggest that the ancients would put this kind of effort, and cost, into a mere burial chamber is ludicrous, at best. So, if the Giza complex was not built as a burial complex, then what the heck was it built for? And why? And what, other than a finely tuned and superbly crafted machine, would require such an incredible level of high tolerance work and more importantly, repeatable high tolerance work, done over and over and over again. In my opinion, Chris Dunn's work is truly an amazing discovery as well as a masterful piece of detective

It is written in a chronological and thoroughly explained manner, so it's really easy to follow and understand. This is a well written book by a guy with know how of how goods are machined and fabricated. He is able to look at a piece of limestone or granite and make a reasonable guess as to how it was made. The implications are that a society with extraordinary engineering and machine production skills existed long before the 'standard' age which is accepted by Egyptologists. Unfortunately, no physical machinery remains, only the work itself. Dunn's theory that the great pyramid was a maser generating power plant implies a high degree of both scientific and engineering knowledge. I do recommended Dunn's work if you are willing to consider alternative historical views. On the downside, I was disappointed that his speculations on when such an advanced society reigned were not conclusive.
