

This volume tells stories from Mr. Herriot's training as an RAF pilot interspersed with reminiscences of his early years in veterinary practice and courtship of his wife, Helen.

Great book. I would have liked to have known that these are not "new" stories, but part of his larger volumes. I enjoy the small size and I don't mind rereading his stories.

BEWARE, I purchased this series thinking they were a continuation of James Herriot's first four but to my disappointment the publisher riped off the public by reprinted the original stories under a new title. I tryed to return them but gave up and donated them to the local library

I couldn't believe it. I discovered another James Herriot book. I had thought I owned them all, and I was delighted to find I was wrong. I purchased the book and began reading. I immediately realized I had read the introductory story in a previous collection, and that was the case for each story in the collection. So, if you've already read James Herriot's first five books, you've read all these stories. I had, but the pleasure I got from re-reading Mr. Herriot's superb prose and meeting the many well-depicted characters in Yorkshire remained undiminished. And if you would prefer a smaller book than the originals, this is a nice fit.
