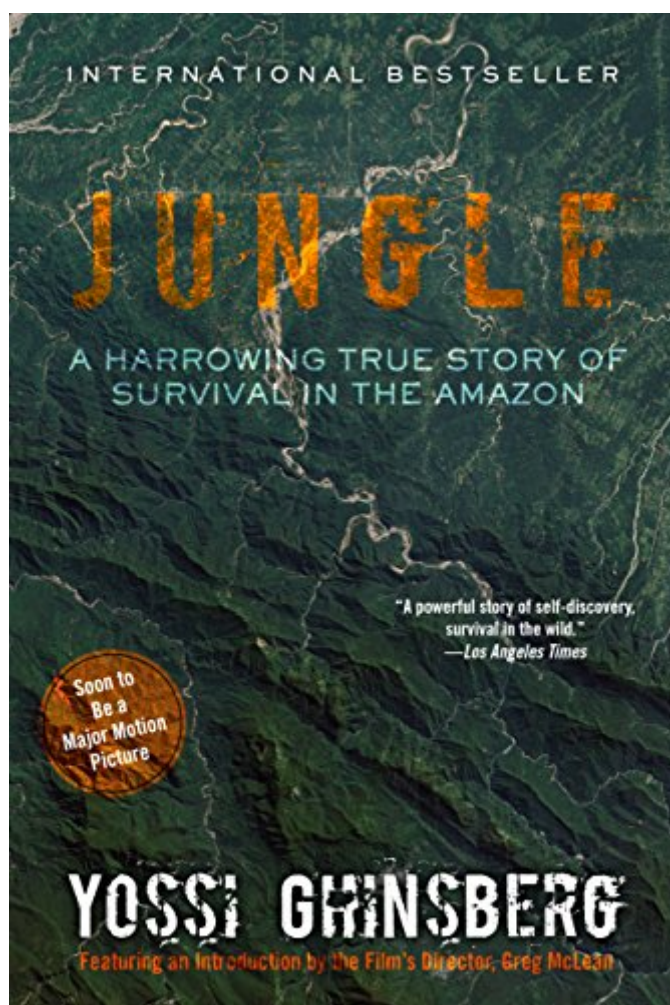

I was sucked into this story until the third quarter. At that point, the action became somewhat redundant and I had no problems skimming. The last quarter and prologue became intriguing again. Overall, an interesting read.

With so many EPIC survival stories--where the narrative unfolds over hundreds of pages--it's hard to feel like Jungle was money well spent. The first half should have been heavily edited (his drug tripping in the desert, for example, is not even tangential to the story), and if Jungle were reduced to the core narrative of survival (which covers just over 15 days), then one wonders if a magazine article could have been a better medium for the story. That said, in and of itself, the story is gripping and, once you get into it, you will likely not put it down until you're finished. But this is probably a book better checked out from the local library than owned--unless you just have to collect survival lit. Also, a small, irritating side note: be prepared to be reminded by the author at every step that clearly he was being watched over and protected by a divine providence, a benevolent providence that sees it fit to rescue him from drowning in bogs but somehow isn't kind enough to just make sure he doesn't fall into them in the first place.

Yossi definitely has more determination than I could have ever mustered in his situation. This true account will speak volumes to you about mind over body. What a survivor!!!!

The book actually is a little slow at the beginning as he feels the need to tell you every detail of his trip even though it has nothing to do with the eventual story. Once you are in the jungle journey, the tale picks up quickly and is quite intriguing. I choose not to disclose the details of the story but strongly encourage you to read this compelling book.
