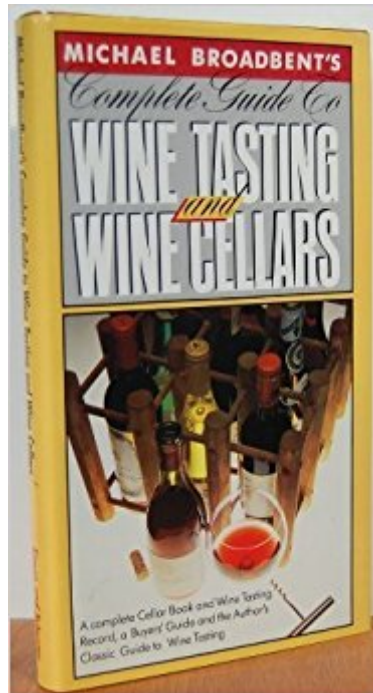

One of the very best books on wine tasting and wine aging. This is not a book to find great wines to drink, or find 95+ point wines. It is pragmatic but deep in what it teaches. I've owned it for decades, just bought this copy to give to a friend. Thought I would enter a note encouraging others to pick up

a copy to read. It is timeless, and if you are serious about wine, you will appreciate it. There are many ways to approach wine to understand. Geography, maps, regions, grapes, terroir are important ... leading to Hugh Johnson and Jancis Robinson. Within this, it is useful to understand what wines age and improve, how wines age, when to drink ... Jancis Robinson and private newsletters. There are also good books on regions, essential for the fervent taster ... burgundy: Coates and Norman, CNDP: Karis. Decades ago I read Broadbent's extensive tasting notes by vintage for great wine regions. Excellent. Learned a lot, helped a lot. The Broadbent book is different. Strongly recommend.

I have gone through about a half dozen books on wine, tasting, and cellaring lately and this is one of the better ones. Well rounded and thorough, it will leave you with a good understanding of the basics and is written well enough to make it enjoyable and interesting to read. Give it a try and then pop the cork on a new wine to celebrate your new knowledge of this interesting hobby.
