Shame on the mailman, and shame on all the rest of us if we EVER see this situation and do not report it! Our first foster daughter was severely retarded, but we love her deeply. So much, in fact, that when her father went to prison for murder, we got custody of her. I cannot imagine ANYONE seeing another human being - no matter how "different" they are (my daughter's IQ is only 34 and she has fetal alcohol syndrome) - being underdressed in the cold, asking them if they don't need more clothes, being told no one would let them in the house to get warmer clothes, KNOWING that to be true from things he had witnessed previously, and DOING NOTHING! That is unconscionable! To later learn this person had literally frozen to death? Yes, the person who had witnessed her out in the cold and underdressed SHOULD feel some degree of guilt over her death! I would beat myself up over it for a very long time! HOWEVER, I would vow to NEVER make that mistake again! It is one thing to see someone homeless on a street somewhere or under a bridge where there are a lot of other homeless people. Sometimes people CHOOSE to live on the street because they truly do not WANT to go to a shelter. But to see someone locked outside of their own home in the freezing cold? What is wrong with us? Call the police, people! As for the homeless people on the streets or under the bridges? Even then we can speak to them. Offer them a warm hat, gloves, a blanket, a coat, a cup of coffee, a hot meal - SOMETHING. A little human kindness goes a long way, and it makes us human as well. Diana may be dead. But if we see her locked out in

the cold and fail to act, she is not the only one that is dead.
