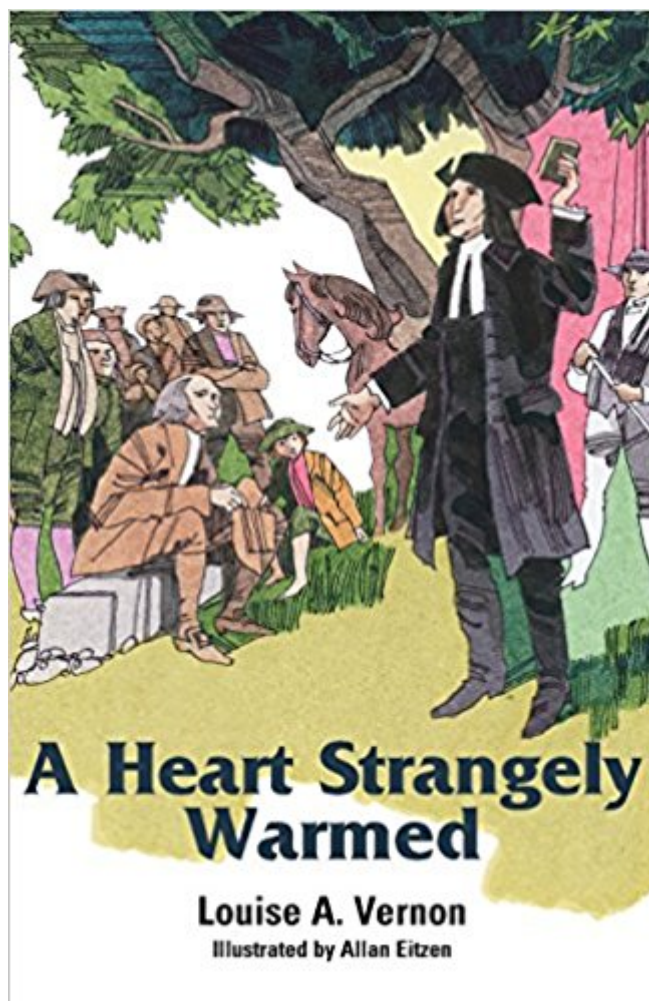


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A Heart Strangely Warmed (Louise A. Vernon Historical Fiction Series, 12)
