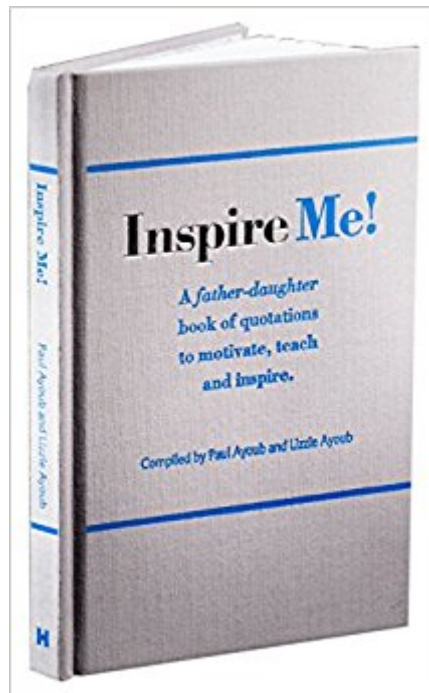




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Inspire Me! A Father-Daughter Book Of Quotations To Motivate, Teach And Inspire
