

A peddler walks around selling caps from a tall, tottering pile on his head. Unable to sell a single cap one morning, he walks out into the countryside, sits down under a tree, checks that all the caps are in place, and falls asleep. When he wakes up, the caps are gone--and the tree is full of cap-wearing monkeys. His attempts to get the caps back generate the kind of repetitive rhythm that 3- and 4-year-olds will adore. He cannot figure out how to get the caps back and he gets frustrated. This is a classic tale. I liked how the peddler showed his frustration and the monkeys followed suit. It teaches children about imitation. It also got the peddler back his caps. It is a fun, easy read.

My sisters and I loved this growing up, and my own children enjoyed the antics I used when reading it to them... now it's on to the grandchildren shaking fists and stomping their feet at the monkeys along with the reading.
