

At first is was kinda creepy that Bray was but once

we learned his reason, it was sorta endearing. Now, here's the parts I didn't quite like. At first Bray came across really alpha but then his character got a little wishy-washy for me. He wasn't good at communicating and his paranoia got on my nerves. The side story of Nico did lend some much-needed drama, but it was almost a bit out of place for some reason. Then there's the editing... I realize you can't catch all the grammatical errors, but when there's 15 (yes, my OCD makes me highlight and count), it's time to find a better editor before you publish your work.

Becs has spent the major part of her life in the foster care system and at the age of eighteen is working a job and trying to better herself. If her constant worries about money weren't bad enough, she feels obligated to look after her older foster brother that is heavily involved in drugs. When she loses her job for reasons she's not entirely clear, she takes her complain to Bray Spencer, the owner of the building that houses the coffee shop she worked for. Bray Spencer is a billionaire recluse that refuses to get involved with the opposite sex due to the unhealthy relationship of his parents. But over the course of a couple of months he becomes enamored with Becs, the colorful pixie, as he calls her. When she storms into his office demanding answers about her job, Bray finally has the opportunity to insert himself into her life. Bray takes her on his live in housekeeper/cook/assistant and eventually his lover. As their relationship gets out, it seems there are forces working from all sides in order to break them up. Will Bray end up just like his father and destroy the one thing he loves most? Will Becs ever be able to trust anyone? Or feel like she won't be left behind, yet again? Maybe it's my age, maybe it's the volume of books I read but I'm finding it harder and harder to suspend disbelief. In the Romance genre there definitely needs to be some bending of timelines, belief, etc., but this book was way over the top. The man is in his mid-30s and is a virgin, who quickly becomes a sex god. He's obsessed with an eighteen year old in a way that makes Christian Grey look like the best boyfriend in the world (like desperately wanting her to get pregnant so she can't leave). He's an investor that has paparazzi stalking him. There is just so much going on in the story without any real storyline, other than once they get it on, they do it a lot. I had picked this one up because the

synopsis looked good and there was a lot of chatter about it in the book world, but it just didn't do it for me. I didn't connect with the characters and the storyline was kind of all over. This was my first book by this author but I would still check out some of her other work. If you're looking for a hot, fast paced read, this one might be for you.

Becs and Bray... I liked them together. I did get tired of Becs, but then realized neither of them talked to each other. The resolution was more convenient than feasible, but this is an Alexa Riley story. Who is looking super-deeply? Riley does well creating vulnerable, quirky heroes, and Bray might be one of my favorites.

I'm a big fan of Alexa Riley, and this story is one of my favorites. I loved Tinks character, she gave no excuse for who she was. She called him Vanilla. He loved her with all her quirks, he never wanted her to change. Troubles came due to misinterpretation. He craved her body. He couldn't hold out against her. Great book. I've reread this many times. Never gets old.

There are so many different reasons I loved this book! Bray has his reasons for getting to the age of 32 without a woman's touch. He refuses to be anything like his father was. OCD and schedules keep Bray from feeling out of control in his life. But there are deeper secrets underneath his custom made thousand dollar suits that very few people know. Rebecca, aka Becs, has had a rough life. Being abandoned at the age of 10 by a mother who made it very clear she didn't want her. As an older kid in the system it's been hard to be placed with a family who isn't trying to change or isn't ashamed of Becs. When order meets chaos sparks fly, hearts are broke and healed, and no book is complete without a little obsession. If I honestly could give this more than 5 stars I would.

This story was full of crazy. He's crazy about her, she's crazy for not realizing how much he loves her. There's crazy addict issues and a crazy obsession that turns the story full circle. Loved that this was one of the longer, fuller stories even if the heroine was getting on my nerves a lot. The age threw me off a bit too. Sexy and fun as usual and I hope Hank has his own story. I really do enjoy everything I read from Alexa Riley, keep them coming ladies.
