

In this volume, we see Guts still following on Casca's steps trying to find her and protect her once again before the Festival comes. The events that unfold provide plenty of entertainment, with all the usual elements the series has: great story, action-packed, exceptional graphics and mature content. On top of that, we get to learn some interesting stuff about some of the after effects the eclipse had on Casca.
