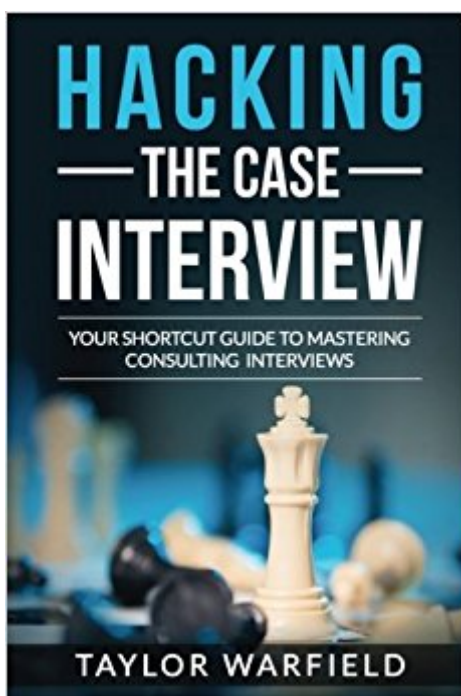




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Hacking The Case Interview: Your Shortcut Guide To Mastering Consulting Interviews

Other than instructing readers on what they need to do and say during every single part of the case interview, what surprised me the most about this book was the attention to detail that the book provides. Every single piece of advice the book recommends is highly tailored towards impressing the interviewer and showing off your case cracking capabilities. For example, the book recommends avoiding the terms “customer” and “customer’s”,

“product”, “company”, and “competition” as they are highly overused terms in frameworks for most candidates. The framework strategy that this book proposes is probably the best framework strategy I have seen out of any of the books that I have read.

Do you remember back in school when you had to read long 300-page+ novels and would later be tested on it? I remember there was a resource out there called “Sparknotes” that would condense everything you needed to know about the book in less than 50 pages or so. Well, this book does exactly that! It is called “Hacking the Case Interview” for a reason. After I finished reading the book, I felt I had acquired the knowledge of someone that has years of experience with case interviews and really knows their stuff.
