

Ok, I loved Warner, Kenji and of course, Juliette. I was happy that Juliette gets the man of her dreams and the one I hoped for all along. I dislike Adam throughout most of this book, but in the end things are looking up for him and James. James, the inquisitive young guy has some awesome scenes with Warner. The winner of the one-liners though is once again, Kenji. I have moments of wishing that Kenji and Juliette would end up together. Most of book is spent preparing for the inevitable battle with the super villain Anderson. Juliette has grown so much, she is no longer the scared, timid girl in the first couple of books. She is ready to use her powers to make things right in the world. It's beautiful to see her journey unfold. Mafi's descriptive talent is awe inspiring. We learn soooo much more about Warner and yes, I have to agree with the other reviewers...*sigh*. This is a YA book, but let me say that the romance is HOT, but one that screams "less information is more"... those that have read this will know what I mean. The slow burn works to perfection here and when the fire finally "ignites" you'll be thrilled!!!! If you're reading this review, hopefully you've read the other books. Hurry up and buy the trilogy's conclusion, you won't be disappointed! If you haven't started the series, what are you waiting for?

On a scale of one to Clockwork Princess, I award Ignite Me a nine. If you know me, you know that I adored Clockwork Princess and it is the conclusion I judge all other conclusions by so long story short: Ignite Me was absolutely amazing. There isn't a single thing I would change about this book. No complaints whatsoever. Juliette has come such a long way over the course of

this series. She has gone from such a weak timid girl to someone you do not want to mess with. Gone is the girl afraid of her own shadow! She is sure of herself and sure in what she wants and determined to forge a better life for herself and for her friends. Gone is her doubt and self-depreciation and in their place is resolve and strength. In a word, she is kickass. Now is the part of the review where I would discuss Warner and Adam and I have so many things I want to say. Unfortunately to do so would be to spoil a whole lot of things so I shall refrain. All I will say is that both characters had some shocking revelations. I also say this; you get your love triangle answer pretty early on. Since I can't discuss those two I will discuss Kenji instead because Kenji is made of awesome. I can't even explain how much I love his character. He is so witty and funny and always a spot of humor in the midst of a lot of destruction and devastation. He is such a great guy and a great friend to Juliette and Juliette really needs a friend. Behind his humor is a wonderful person and someone Juliette can really count on and I love that she finally found that. Tahereh's writing in Ignite Me was gorgeous. It was a slightly different style from her previous novels, but that really reflects how Juliette has grown. Her writing just flows and I feel like it really allows you to feel like you are really living inside Juliette's head. There are so many more things I want to say about the perfection that is Ignite Me. Unfortunately I can't because all of them would spoil this wonderful book. It was just a wonderful conclusion to a wonderful series. Just read it!

The premise is an interesting one and the potential for an intriguing and captivating story is there, however the prose, and delivery was lacking. The character development was good, but at the same time, it felt like it could have been better. I could see where the relationship would pivot and where the emotions would develop, but upon reaching these points... I felt like I was being told about their feelings and not shown. I kind of want to buy the second book just to see what happens, but am not certain I would be captivated by it. It has massive amounts of potential, but I just thought it was ok.

I have read this book three times. The first time, I was blown by it. But after thinking it through, I realized that this was just not that good of a book. The writing style is just SO wonderful and beautiful, but the author's choices as far as the plot goes just really left to be desired. The author shouldn't have tried to push Warner down our throats. She killed Adam's character (figuratively) to try and make us hate him, and that's just not okay. I would have vouched for Warner no matter what. The romance just overtook the whole book... There is a war coming and all Juliette can think

about is which boy she loves.Juliette's unrealistic transformation: ugh! Can authors please STOP shoving unrealistic female characters down our throats just because the publishing industry demands it. I loved Juliette just fine before she became a psychopath.Finally, the side characters were just flat. Why even have any side characters? I can't even remember their names because they were so boring.With that being said, the love story was just beautiful and the writing is just flawless.I just wish Tahereh Mafi didn't feel the need to follow trends because she completely butchered her character.
