

## **Customer Reviews**

Curt J. Zoller, book collector and columnist for "Finest Hour," the magazine published by the Churchill Centre, has produced that rare sort of bibliography, one for which experts have actually read the books they comment upon. Chief among Zoller's contributors was Richard Langworth, editor of "Finest Hour," Chairman of the board of the Ch. Centre, and proprietor of Churchillbooks. But Zoller also obtained the services of librarians from around the world, including Japan, which, naturally enough, produced quite a few titles on Chachiru. The bibliography has five sections: (A) books entirely about Churchill -- these have the fullest annotations, covering both technical information (e.g., page counts, editions, translations, etc.) and, in the words of Foreword writer Langworth, "what you can expect from each work--what it contains and. quite frankly, whether it is any good or not." Over 684 entries are found in section A, though the number of separately published volumes of multi-volume works runs to over 700. The years of publication run from 1905,

when the first bio of Churchill (then 31) was published, to 2004. As with any bibliography such as this, and certainly in Churchill's case, it is outdated quickly. The final volume of THE LAST LION, for example, arrived years too late to make this volume; (B) contains over 900 entries on books that are not about Churchill per se, but do contain substantial information about him. This section is limited (to keep the bibliography manageable and affordable) to works in English. Encyclopedias and general historical surveys are omitted. Section C includes over 600 articles about Churchill. To keep this section from exploding, the list is limited to articles based on serious research. Section D includes book reviews in English language periodicals of books written by Churchill, from an 1898 review of The Story of the Malakand Field Force to a 1961 review of Churchill's The American Civil War (excerpted from the HESP, v4). Section E lists dissertations and theses about WSC available from ProQuest. Listings are chronological by publication date. Fortunately, the editor has included indices of Author Names and Titles. I bought this book because I have it in my head to do a bibliography on an American historical figure, and I wanted an example of how to do it right. Zoller's book indeed serves as the model of how to balance comprehensiveness, quality, usefulness, and affordability.
