


The book was found

Not with The Angling Times, though, which commissioned the Bad Angler columns. A few of them are included here â€“ the rest are collected in The Complete Bad Angler. There follows an extract from Year of the Spider, which documents a yearâ€™s fly fishing on the River Tees in the North-East of England using spider patterns from TE Prittâ€™s 19th Century classic, Yorkshire Trout Flies. The collection finishes with a recipe from Cooking for Dads â€“ a book written at the behest of a publisher just before the worldwide financial crash pushed promises between gentlemen onto the back burner and then turned off the gas.
