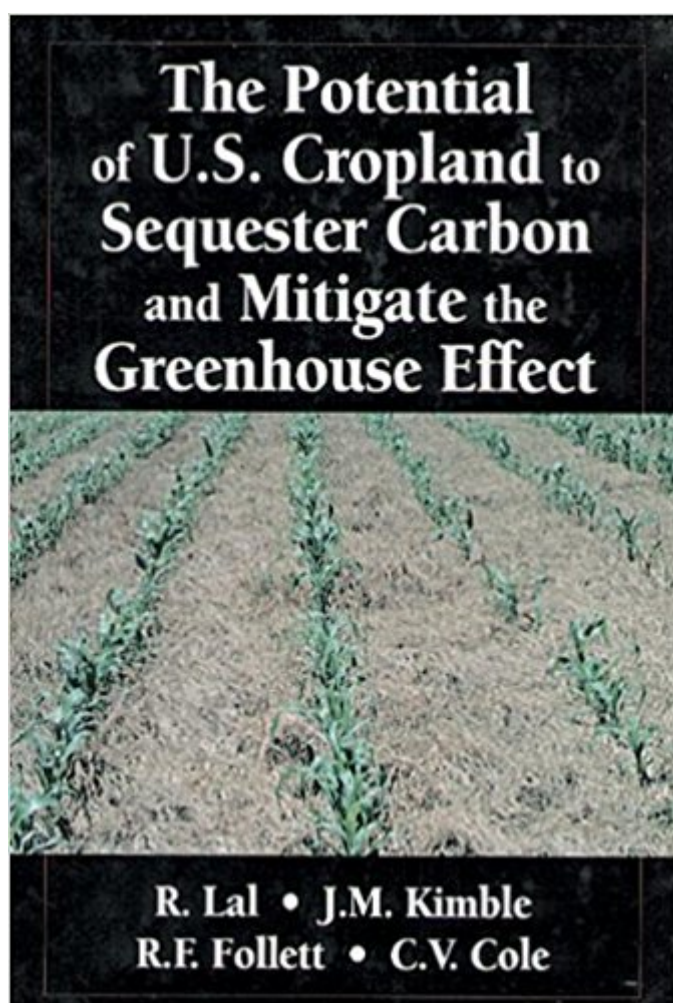


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The Potential Of U.S. Cropland To Sequester Carbon And Mitigate The Greenhouse Effect
