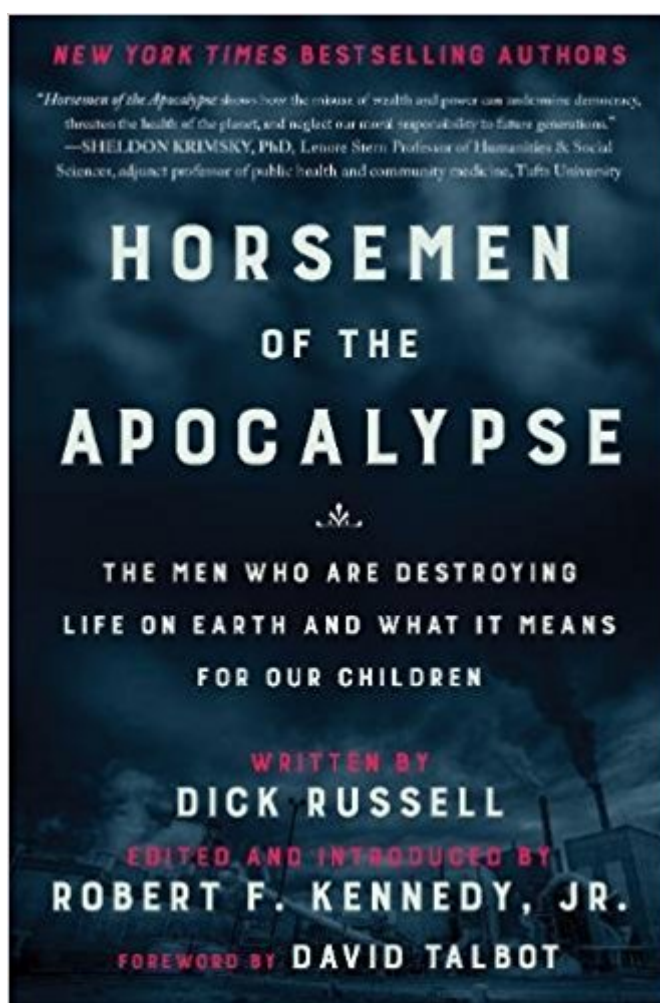


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Horsemen Of The Apocalypse: The Men Who Are Destroying Life On Earth—And What It Means For Our Children

Russell is a fabulous writer (also enjoyed reading his book *Striper Wars* and many articles), and he convincingly indicts these fossil fuel barons for their ongoing crimes against humanity. You'll walk away understanding in a lot more depth the need to get off fossil fuels now, and a sense of outrage that these characters walk freely. Chapter 7 on Peabody's war on children was especially blood-boiling for me.
