

Don't let the clever and cute book layout design (and concept-reinforcing drawings) fool you, every bit of this book is comedic gold. Really boils down tons of comedic acting theory into quickly understood and applied techniques and exercises that'll make just about any willing soul more authentically and more automatically clever under stress. Most essentially, this book will benefit anyone willing to look foolish and give all the spotlight to his/her teammates, which of course, is the golden ingredient that makes performances sizzle. Only wish I had bought this years ago.

Its amazing to me how many games, ideas, and 'rules' of improv are covered in this book. As I take classes from a completely different institution, I can now say that this book is the ultimate companion to any aspiring improviser. The practice game examples are all staples of any theater, and every idea is laid out with ample examples including some from real UCB teams. Even if you aren't attending UCB or plan to learn at another theater, this is your book. Beautiful graphics and full color pages throughout!
