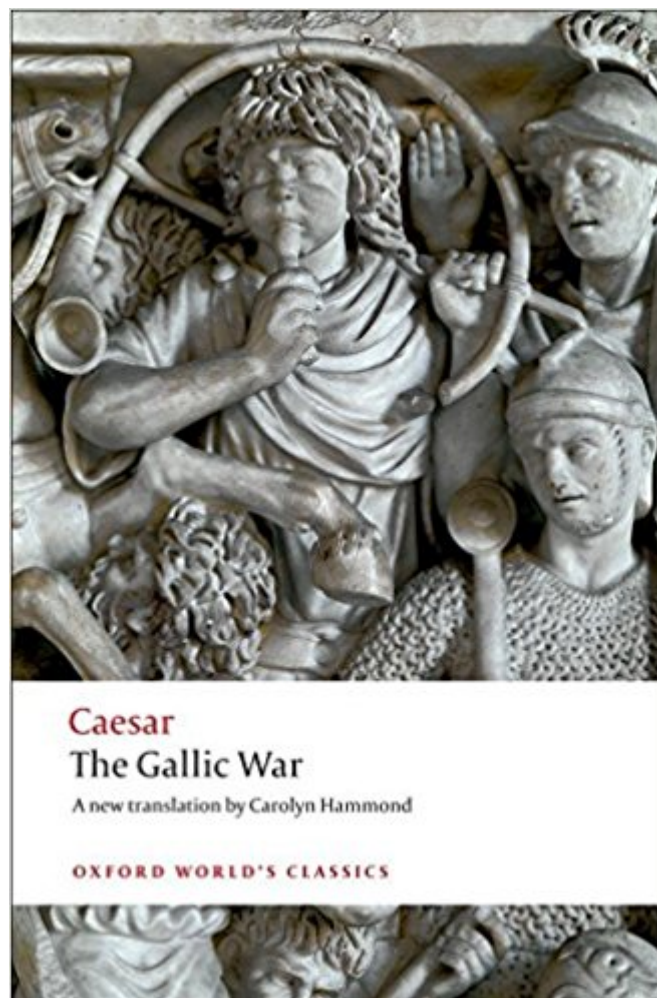

There is a mistake on page XX in the introduction. it is discussing the size and divisions of the Roman army and in reference to the maniple, says they are composed of "zoo men." The front matter is pretty good in giving one a decent understanding of the book, but the actual translation isn't much different than some of the free ones I've read.
